The Colorado Attorney General is reviewing the arbitrator's decision made in August because a state law forbids transferring ownership of hospitals if it limits healthcare services in the communities they serve. The Attorney General has the final say!
So the citizens group sent a letter begging the AG to:

STOP the transfer. **HOLD** public hearings.
Allow the public to ask questions and express their views.

Tell him you do not want our Colorado-built, locally-funded hospitals to be taken over by an out-of-state company. We shouldn't have to compete for our own healthcare earnings!

He needs to hear directly from the public affected.
